Skyview Park Erosion Work Complete

The City of Fort Collins has officially completed the new inlet drain at the park entrance, at no cost to the HOA. The upgrade has been tested by the record rainfall recorded in June, and was able to handle the unusual amount of run-off during these storms. Additionally, it just looks so much better then the old drainage system!

The HOA will now continue work to mitigate erosion and beautify the entrance to the park. Plans include cleanup of the concrete rabble, invasive species removal, and reseeding with native flowers and grasses to hold the soil.

Additionally, the board has added doggie clean-up stations at the entrance and the playground, more picnic tables and benches, additional mowing to widen the trails, and Russian olive removal along the creek to improve stream flow and wildlife habitat
